***RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE BID,  
PURCHASE, AND DISPOSITION BY SURPLUS OF FIREARMS  
AND AMENDING FISCAL YEAR BUDGET 2023-2024  
RE: SHERIFF'S OFFICE***

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office requests the authority to:

1) accept a bid to purchase firearms that includes an offset associated with the disposition of firearms to be replaced; 2) declare surplus 84 Bushmaster XM 15 rifles; 3) use asset forfeiture reserves; and 4) increase the budget of law enforcement equipment to purchase new duty weapons; and

WHEREAS, at its March 7, 2024 meeting the Public Safety Committee recommended consideration and approval of this request; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office requests the following amendments to Fiscal Year Budget 2023-2024 for the purchase of firearms:

1. Decrease \$35,658.00 from equity line item 101-34525-821 (Restricted for Public Safety – Asset Forfeiture Reserve);
2. Increase \$35,658.00 to expense line item 101-54110-716-821 (Sheriff's Department-Law Enforcement Equipment); and

WHEREAS, at its March 7, 2024 meeting the Public Safety Committee recommended consideration and approval of this request; and

WHEREAS, the Budget Committee at its March 13, 2024 meeting recommended consideration and approval of this request to the Board of County Commissioners; now therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, TENNESSEE THAT:**

**SECTION 1:** The Board of County Commissioners hereby approves the Sheriff's Office requests to: 1) accept a bid to purchase firearms that includes an offset associated with the disposition of firearms to be replaced; 2) declare surplus 84 Bushmaster XM 15 rifles; 3) use asset forfeiture reserves; and 4) increase the budget of law enforcement equipment to purchase new duty weapons.

SECTION 2. Fiscal Year Budget 2023-2024 is amended to:

1. Decrease \$35,658.00 from equity line item 101-34525-821 (Restricted for Public Safety – Asset Forfeiture Reserve);
2. Increase \$35,658.00 to expense line item 101-54110-716-821 (Sheriff's Department-Law Enforcement Equipment); and

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect from and after the date on which it is approved by the County Mayor or as indicated by certification of the County Clerk, as hereinafter set forth.
