**RESOLUTION AMENDING FISCAL YEAR 2025 BUDGET
RE: FOOD INSECURITY**

WHEREAS, Resolution 23-01-22 was approved on January 23, 2024 authorizing Washington County, Tennessee's acceptance and execution of the food insecurity CV community development block grant in an amount of \$500,000.00 to cover the acquisition of food preparation equipment, and transportation vehicles for use by designated non-profit organizations; and

WHEREAS, the First Tennessee Development District (FTDD) is administering the grant; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor requests the following amendments to Fiscal Year 2025 Budget since no funding was requested or allocated for this purpose in the FY24 budget:

1. Increase \$28,254.00 to expense line item 101-58833-310-100 (American Rescue Plan Act Grant- Contracts with Other Agencies);
2. Increase \$51,746.00 to expense line item 101-58833-710-100 (American Rescue Plan Act Grant- Food Service Equipment);
3. Increase \$420,000.00 to expense line item 101-58833-718-100 (American Rescue Plan Act Grant- Motor Vehicles);
4. Increase \$500,000.00 to revenue line item 101-47402-100 (American Rescue Plan Act Grant-); and

WHEREAS, the Budget Committee at its October 16, 2024 meeting recommended consideration and approval of this request to the Board of County Commissioners; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, TENNESSEE THAT:

SECTION 1. Fiscal Year 2025 Budget is amended to:


1. Increase \$28,254.00 to expense line item 101-58833-310-100 (American Rescue Plan Act Grant- Contracts with Other Agencies).
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4. Increase \$500,000.00 to revenue line item 101-47402-100 (American Rescue Plan Act Grant-).


