RESOLUTION AMENDING FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025 BUDGET RE: ASSESSOR'S OFFICE- PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX RETURNS

WHEREAS, the Assessor's Office requests the following amendments to Fiscal Year 2025 Budget to provide funding for 3rd party processing of 2024 personal property schedules:

1. Increase \$8,000.00 to expense line item 101-52310-317 (Reappraisal Program- Data Processing Services);
2. Decrease \$5,700.00 from expense line item 101-52300-334 (Property Assessor's Office- Maintenance Agreements);
3. Decrease \$1,000.00 from expense line item 101-52300-348 (Property Assessor's Office - Postal Charges);
4. Decrease \$1,000.00 from expense line item 101-52300-349 (Property Assessor's Office - Printing, Stationery, and Forms);
5. Decrease \$300.00 from expense line item 101-52300-453 (Property Assessor's Office - Vehicle Parts); and

WHEREAS, the Budget Committee at its January 15, 2025 meeting recommended consideration and approval of this request to the Board of County Commissioners; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, TENNESSEE THAT:


SECTION 1. Fiscal Year 2025 Budget is amended to:

1. Increase \$8,000.00 to expense line item 101-52310-317 (Reappraisal Program- Data Processing Services).
2. Decrease \$5,700.00 from expense line item 101-52300-334 (Property Assessor's Office- Maintenance Agreements).
3. Decrease \$1,000.00 from expense line item 101-52300-348 (Property Assessor's Office - Postal Charges).
4. Decrease \$1,000.00 from expense line item 101-52300-349 (Property Assessor's Office - Printing, Stationery, and Forms).
5. Decrease \$300.00 from expense line item 101-52300-453 (Property Assessor's Office - Vehicle Parts).




