***RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING CERTAIN
EDUCATION CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND EXPENDITURES UP TO
\$142,375.00 IN FY25 FOR THE PURCHASE AND DEPLOYMENT OF
WEARABLE CRISIS RESPONSE ALERT HARDWARE,
INFRASTRUCTURE, AND REQUIRED DIGITAL MAPPING***

WHEREAS, the Capital Projects Funds Policy, adopted August 29, 2016 (Resolution 16-08-14), requires an enabling Resolution approved by the County Commission, identifying a specific project or use of capital funds prior to expenditure or transfer from the Capital Projects Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Schools requests authorization to spend up to \$142,375.00 of budgeted funds for the purchase and deployment of wearable crisis response alert hardware, infrastructure, and required digital mapping in FY25 from the Education Capital Project Fund (177-95100-709), Capital Projects Donated to School Department-Data Processing Equipment; and

WHEREAS, at its February 6, 2025 meeting the Health Education & Welfare Committee recommended consideration and approval of this request; and

WHEREAS, at its February 12, 2025 meeting the Budget Committee recommended consideration and approval of this request to the Board of County Commissioners; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, TENNESSEE THAT:

SECTION 1. The Board of County Commissioners approves and authorizes the expenditure in an amount not to exceed \$142,375.00, from expense line item 177-95100-709, Capital Projects Donated to School Department-Data Processing Equipment, for the purchase and deployment of wearable crisis response alert hardware, infrastructure, and required digital mapping

SECTION 2. The County Purchasing Agent and County Mayor are authorized to execute all necessary documents, subject to the approval of the County Attorney.


SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect from and after the date on which it is approved by the County Mayor or as indicated by certification of the County Clerk, as hereinafter set forth.


