**RESOLUTION AMENDING FISCAL YEAR BUDGET 2024-2025  
RE: FULL-TIME INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SPECIALIST**

WHEREAS, the Mayor requests a budget amendment for additional funding for a full-time information technology specialist to assist county officials, department heads and employees in their day-to-day technology needs ;and

WHEREAS, the Mayor requests the following amendments to Fiscal Year Budget 2024-2025:

1. Increase \$13,613.00 to expense line item 101-51900-189 (Other General Administration-Other Salaries and Wages);
2. Increase \$845.00 to expense line item 101-51900-201 (Other General Administration-Social Security);
3. Increase \$197.00 to expense line item 101-51900-212 (Other General Administration-Employer Medicare);
4. Increase \$1,485.00 to expense line item 101-51900-205 (Other General Administration-Employee and Dependent Insurance);
5. Decrease \$16,140.00 from equity line item 101-39000 (Fund Balance); and

WHEREAS, the Budget Committee at its April 9, 2025 meeting recommended consideration and approval of this request to the Board of County Commissioners; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, TENNESSEE THAT:

SECTION 1. Fiscal Year Budget 2024-2025 is amended to:

1. Increase \$13,613.00 to expense line item 101-51900-189 (Other General Administration-Other Salaries and Wages).
2. Increase \$845.00 to expense line item 101-51900-201 (Other General Administration-Social Security).
3. Increase \$197.00 to expense line item 101-51900-212 (Other General Administration-Employer Medicare).
4. Increase \$1,485.00 to expense line item 101-51900-205 (Other General Administration-Employee and Dependent Insurance).
5. Decrease \$16,140.00 from equity line item 101-39000 (Fund Balance).


