RESOLUTION AMENDING FISCAL YEAR BUDGET 2024-2025 RE: CODES COMPLIANCE- HURRICANE HELENE- CONTRACTED ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT

WHEREAS, as a result of Hurricane Helene the workload on county staff in the Zoning, Planning & Building Offices continues to require additional resources to keep current; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning, Planning & Building Offices requests the following amendments to Fiscal Year Budget 2024-2025 to extend contracted administrative support through the end of the current year:

1. Increase \$8,400.00 to expense line items 101-51750-312-24 (Codes Compliance – Contracts with Private Agencies);
2. Decrease \$8,400.00 from equity line item 101-39000 (Fund Balance); and

WHEREAS, the Budget Committee at its May 7, 2025 meeting recommended consideration and approval of this request to the Board of County Commissioners; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, TENNESSEE THAT:

SECTION 1. Fiscal Year 2025 Budget is amended to:

1. Increase \$8,400.00 to expense line items 101-51750-312-24 (Codes Compliance – Contracts with Private Agencies).
2. Decrease \$8,400.00 from equity line item 101-39000 (Fund Balance).

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect from and after the date on which it is approved by the County Mayor or as indicated by certification of the County Clerk, as hereinafter set forth.
