RESOLUTION NO. 25-11-20

RESOLUTION AMENDING FY26 BUDGET RE: SAFETY DIRECTOR STIPEND

Whereas, in addition to the duties associated with serving as the Solid Waste Director, the position has also been assigned the responsibilities of the Safety Officer for Washington County which provides a salary stipend that has remained the same amount of \$265.69 (biweekly) since FY24; and

WHEREAS, the County Mayor requests the following amendments to FY26 to increase the stipend to \$290.00 biweekly effective with pay period ending January 11, 2026:

1. Increase \$321.00 to expense line item 101-54900-105 (Other Public Safety - Supervisor/Director);
2. Increase \$20.00 to expense line item 101-54900-201 (Other Public Safety - Social Security);
3. Increase \$45.00 to expense line item 101-54900-204 (Other Public Safety - Pensions);
4. Increase \$5.00 to expense line item 101-54900-212 (Other Public Safety - Employer Medicare);
5. Decrease \$391.00 from equity line item 101-39900 (Fund Balance);

WHEREAS, the Budget Committee at its November 12, 2025 meeting recommended consideration and approval of this request to the Board of County Commissioners; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, TENNESSEE THAT:

SECTION 1. Fiscal Year Budget 2025-2026 is amended to:

1. Increase \$321.00 to expense line item 101-54900-105 (Other Public Safety - Supervisor/Director).
2. Increase \$20.00 to expense line item 101-54900-201 (Other Public Safety - Social Security).
3. Increase \$45.00 to expense line item 101-54900-204 (Other Public Safety - Pensions).
4. Increase \$5.00 to expense line item 101-54900-212 (Other Public Safety - Employer Medicare).
5. Decrease \$391.00 from equity line item 101-39900 (Fund Balance).

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect from and after the date on which it is approved by the County Mayor or as indicated by certification of the County Clerk, as hereinafter set forth.




